## Get the best results from your Podcast Pro microphone...

- Podcast Pro is supplied with a thread adaptor inside the stand connector section allowing you to mount it on a mic stand with one of the two regular sizes. Keep the thread adaptor in to fix the mic to a stand with 3/8" and unscrew and remove it in order to fix it to a stand with 5/8" thread.
- Position the microphone so that the end grille is around 15-20cm from your mouth.
- The closer you get to the mic, the more intimate the sound (a technique used by radio presenters).
- The microphone has built-in protection behind the front grille to reduce plosives (P and B sounds) and sibilance from S, Z, SH and CH sounds.
- To reduce them still further, position the mic so it's slightly off centre from the line between it and your mouth.
- The Podcast Pro has been deliberately designed with a higher output than most other dynamic microphones. This means you won't need as much input level (on your interface or recording software) and therefore background noise from the room you are recording in is kept to a minimum.
- Podcast Pro can be used anywhere, either via an interface/mixer or via our Sontronics XLR-USB cable that plugs straight into a computer or laptop.
   Podcast Pro users are recording their podcasts everywhere, from kitchen tables, classrooms and hotel rooms to outdoor cafés, public transport and even ski lifts!
